MEMBERS CHILD PROTECTION UNDERTAKING (Form 5)

Clontarf Lawn Tennis Club Child Protection Policy* agrees to abide by the guidelines as set out in the Policy and in particular to abide by the **Code of Ethics & Good Practice for Children's Sport**, such that it has added specific rules into the Club Rules on this matter.

Please see the specific 2020 Club Rules below:

Rule 18:

It is a condition of membership of Clontarf Lawn Tennis Club that members uphold and support the Child Protection Policy of the Club. This Policy is posted on the Club Noticeboard and on the Club Website.

Rule 60:

- A. Clontarf Lawn Tennis Club is fully committed to safeguarding the well-being of its members. Every individual in the Club should at all times show respect and understanding for their rights, safety and welfare and conduct themselves in a way that reflects the principles of the Club and the guidelines contained in the Code of Ethics and Good Practice for Children's Sport in Ireland.
- B. The Club is committed to appoint at least one children's officer as outlined in the code or one children's officer for each gender.
- C. The Club is committed to designate the Club Chairperson to act as a liaison with the Statutory Authorities in relation to the reporting of all allegations or suspicions of child abuse. Any such reports should be made according to the procedures outlined in this Code under Children First/ Our duty of Care.
